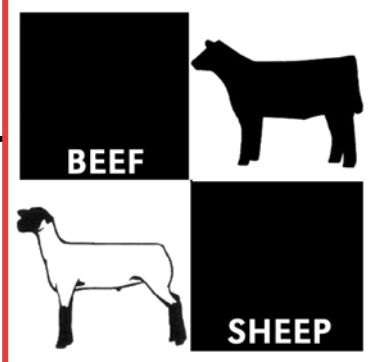

2010 RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Show Information:

This show is open to all Nebraska 4-H and FFA members. Exhibitors must be 8 years old by January 1st and have not passed their 21st birthday by January 1st of the current year. Livestock may be brought in after 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 28. The Show Committee will have the final decision on class breaks and registration paper discrepancies. **Please bring your own bedding!**

Dress: Show attire – 4-H/FFA shirt not required. NO halter tops or sleeveless shirts/blouses.

Beef Show Information

Breeding Heifers: Heifers must be born between 9/1/08 and 12/31/09. Heifers will be shown by breeds. All registration papers must be presented at check-in. Heifers without papers will show in the commercial class. All breeding heifers must be identified by legible ear tattoo(s).

Showmanship: Senior Division - 16 and older as of January 1, 2010
Intermediate Division - 12-15 as of January 1, 2010
Junior Division - 11 and under as of January 1, 2010

Market Heifers: Market heifers must be born in 2009. All heifers will be shown in one division and classes will be divided by hip height.

Market Steers: Steers must be born in 2009. Steers will be shown by breed. Classes will be divided by hip height. All registration papers must be presented at check-in. Steers without papers will show in the commercial class.

All market beef **must have a current Nebraska 4-H or FFA ear tag in place** to be eligible to show.

Sanctioned Show:

This is a Junior Nebraska Cattlemen (JNC) sanctioned show. All JNC rules will be enforced and posted the day of the show.

Swine Show Information

Showmanship: Senior Division - 15 and older as of January 1, 2010
Intermediate Division - 12-14 as of January 1, 2010
Junior Division - 8-11 as of January 1, 2010

Mkt & Brdg: All swine must have a current Nebraska 4-H or FFA ear tag in place, or identified by the Universal ear notch system in both ears to be eligible to show.

Breeding Gilts: All breeding gilts must be born after January 1 of the current year.

Breeds if 3 head or more entered in division

Market Swine: Open to barrows & gilts

Breeds if 5 head or more entered in division

Show Order: Showmanship, Breeding Gilts, Market Swine

Meat Goat & Sheep Show Information

Showmanship: Senior Division - 15 and older as of January 1, 2010
Intermediate Division - 12-14 as of January 1, 2010
Junior Division - 8-11 as of January 1, 2010

Breeding Goats: Yearling nannies must be born between 1/1/09 and 12/31/09. Spring nannies must be born after 1/1/10. Classes will be divided by age.

Meat Goats: All meat goats **must have a 4-H or FFA identification tag**. Meat goats will be shown by weight. No re-weighs. Goats are to have milk teeth and there shall be no evidence of braking of the skin or eruption of the two permanent front teeth.

Goats must have horns blunted.

Goats are to be shown with neck chains or smooth collars only.

Market goats may be doe or wether kids. Short scrotum, cyrtorchid and buck kids are not eligible. Does and wethers will show together. No Dairy Goats.

Breeding Ewes: Ewe lambs must be born after 1/1/10. Aged ewes must be born between 1/1/09 and 12/31/09. Classes will be divided by breeds. All registration papers must be presented at check-in. Ewes without papers will show in the crossbred class.

Market Lambs: All market lambs **must have a 4-H or FFA identification tag**. Market lambs will be shown by weight. No re-weighs.
