A. Breeding Heifers

All registered heifers will show in their respective breed class. Heifers without papers will show in the commercial breed class. Classes are divided as follows:

1. January - February
2. March - April
3. May - June
4. July - August
5. September - October
6. November - December

Breeding Heifer Champions will be selected as each breed is shown. Supreme Heifer will be selected at the conclusion of the Breeding Heifer show.

B. Senior Showmanship (16-21 years of age on January 1)

C. Intermediate Showmanship (12-15 years of age on January 1)

D. Junior Showmanship (8-11 years of age on January 1)

Showmanship exhibitors must use animals entered in their own name at this show.

E. Market Heifers

1. Shown by hip height; shortest to tallest
2. Selection of Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Heifer

F. Market Steers

1. Shown by hip height; shortest to tallest
2. Selection of Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Steer
3. Selection of Overall Champion Market Beef
